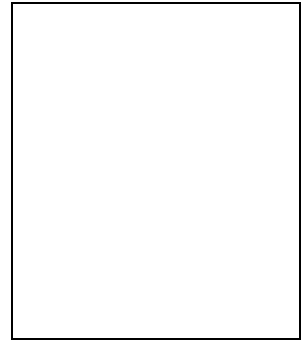

- III. **Congressional Nomination Application (Complete)**. The application includes:
 - 1) **Personal Information**
 - 2) **Personal Commentary**: 500-word essay about yourself, your goals, and reasons you would like to attend a Service Academy.
 - 3) **Two Teacher Recommendations**: Use the recommendation forms included in the application. Teachers should complete the forms, seal them in envelopes, and return the forms to the student. The forms must arrive with the application package in sealed envelopes. Separate letters of recommendation are NOT required.
 - 4) **Interview Request Form**
- IV. **Official High School Transcripts**: Transcripts must arrive with the application in a SEALED envelope. Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.
- V. **Official SAT and/or ACT scores**: Congressman Carbajal's code number **4458** (SAT) and **7263** (ACT).
