## 1SEC. 2. EXCLUSION OF VETERANS DISABILITY BENEFITS2FROM INCOME.

3 The Department of Housing and Urban Development
4 Act (42 U.S.C. 3531 et seq.) is amended by adding at
5 the end the following new section:

# 6 "SEC. 15. EXCLUSION OF VETERANS DISABILITY BENEFITS 7 FROM INCOME.

8 "Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any 9 amounts received by any member of a household or family 10 as disability compensation under chapter 11 of title 38, 11 United States Code, or dependency and indemnity com-12 pensation under chapter 13 of such title, shall not be con-13 sidered as income of such household or family for purposes 14 of—

15 "(1) determining the eligibility of such family
16 or household for assistance under any program for
17 housing assistance administered by the Secretary;

18 "(2) the amount of benefits payable to or on
19 behalf of such family or household under such pro20 gram; or

21 "(3) the amount of rent paid by such family or
22 household for occupancy of a dwelling unit assisted
23 under any such program.".
