I am requesting funding for the County of Santa Barbara: Sanctuary Centers Hollister II in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is located at 115 West Anapamu Street, Santa Barbara, CA 93101.

The funding would be used for construction of 34 new studio apartment and a neighborhood clinic space to provide affordable housing and support services for residents who struggle with homelessness, mental illness, and substance use disorders. These new studio apartments will nearly double the number of individuals Sanctuary can assist in the journey toward independence. Additionally, the new building will include 10 supported, independent living units. These specialized units will enable Sanctuary to provide a higher-level of 24/7 care than previously possible.
